 keep everything eco-friendly.

- Promote Sustainable Travel:

 Offer shuttle services or incentives for carpooling. Better yet, consider hybrid or virtual options to cut down on travel emissions..
- 4 Say No to Single-Use Plastics:
 Swap plastic for bamboo, bioplastics,
 or reusable décor.
- 6 Manage Waste Efficiently:
 Set up recycling and composting stations, and donate leftover food to local charities.
- 7 Install Refill Stations:
 Replace bottled water with refill
 stations to reduce plastic waste.
